Classic driving gloves

Page 1/1, cable instructions only.

These instructions replace the missing chart.. They are for the 31 (35) sts of the back of the left hand, starting at the first st after the MIL of the thumb. You may like to place a marker at st 31 (35) after the MIL, before the 31 (35) sts of the palm so that it is clear where the cable instructions fit.

Row 11: k 31 (35) (these are the 24 (28) sts of the back of hand plus the 7 sts at the side back of hand)

Row 12: p 31 (35)

Row 13: k 31 (35)

Row 14: p7 (11), k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p8

Row 15: k8, p1, c4f, p1, c4f, p1, c4f, p1, k7 (11)

Row 16: p7 (11), k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p8

Row 17: k8, p1, k4, p1, k4, p1, k4, p1, k7 (11)

Row 18: p7 (11), k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p4, k1, p8

Row 19: k6, k2tog, p1, c4f, p1, m1, c4f, p1, m1rev, c4f, p1, ssk, k 5 (9)

Row 20: p6 (10), k1, p4, k2, p4, k2, p4, k1, p7

Row 21: k7, p1, k4, p2, k4, p2, k4, p1, k6 (10)

Row 22: p6 (10), k1, p4, k2, p4, k2, p4, k1, p7

Row 23: k7, p1, c4f, p2, c4f, p2, c4f, p1, k 6 (10)

Row 24: p4 (8), p2togtbl, k1, p4, k1, m1rev, k1, p4, k1, m1rev, k1, p4, k1, p2tog, p5

Row 25: k6, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k5 (9)

Row 26: p5 (9), k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p6

Row 27: k6, p1, c4f, p1, k1, p1, c4f, p1, k1, p1, c4f, p1, k5 (9)

Row 28: p5 (9), k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p6

Row 29: k4, k2tog, p1, k4, p1, m1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, m1rev, p1, k4, p1, ssk, k3 (7)

Row 30: p4 (8), k1, p4, k1, p2, k1, p4, k1, p2, k1, p4, k1, p5

Row 31: k5, p1, c4f, p1, k2, p1, c4f, p1, k2, p1, c4f, p1, k4 (8)

Row 32: p4 (8), k1, p4, k1, p2, k1, p4, k1, p2, k1, p4, k1, p 5

Row 33: k5, p1, k4, p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k4 (8)

Row 34: p2 (6), p2togtbl, k1, p4, k1, m1rev, p2, k1, p4, k1, p2, m1, k1, p4, k1, p2tog, p3

Row 35: k4, p1, c4f, p1, k3, p1, c4f, p1, k3, p1, c4f, p1, k3 (7)

Row 36: p3 (7), k1, p4, k1, p3, k1, p4, k1, p3, k1, p4, k1, p4

The printed instructions in the ‘hand’ section say to continue with the chart for 36 (40) rounds. This should read 36 rounds only.

Then continue with the printed instructions where it says knit 5 (8) rounds. Then work the pinkie finger.
